November 13 Day of Action

On Monday, November. 13, people across the United States will visit the district offices of their senators and representatives to honor the dead and demand an end to the mass killing of people in Gaza. Congress votes to send billions of dollars to Israel to buy even more bombs — already more than 10,000 people have been killed in less than a month, including over 4,100 children.
