


A MAP FOR FALASTEEN: A PALESTINIAN CHILD'S SEARCH FOR HOME

Oraib, a young Palestinian girl, harvests olives with her mother. When her family is displaced from their home, she must leave her olive groves behind.

EVERYTHING GROWS IN JIDDO'S GARDEN

In this simple, rhyming story accompanied by vibrant illustrations, the protagonist's grandfather tells her about his garden and his homeland in Palestine.

HOMELAND: MY FATHER DREAMS OF PALESTINE

The protagonist's father tells her bedtime stories about his childhood as a Palestinian Christian in Jerusalem, visiting his grandfather's cafe and getting to know his neighbors.

SITTI'S BIRD: A GAZA STORY



Written and Illustrated by Malak Mattar AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL - AGES 5+

In Gaza, a young Malak uses painting to express herself and overcome the trauma of living through Israel's 2014 airstrikes on Gaza. This book is a warm, hopeful reflection on the power of art and family in times of great fear.
